




This is a map of a subway. A map is a drawing that can help you find places.

Maps used to be made out of paper. A book of maps is called an atlas. Today, many people use maps on their phone.






Maps are not the same as photos. Look at this photo of Paris, France. Now look at the map. What do you see? Colors on maps have meanings.

Blue means water, like an ocean or a river.


Where is the water on this map?
