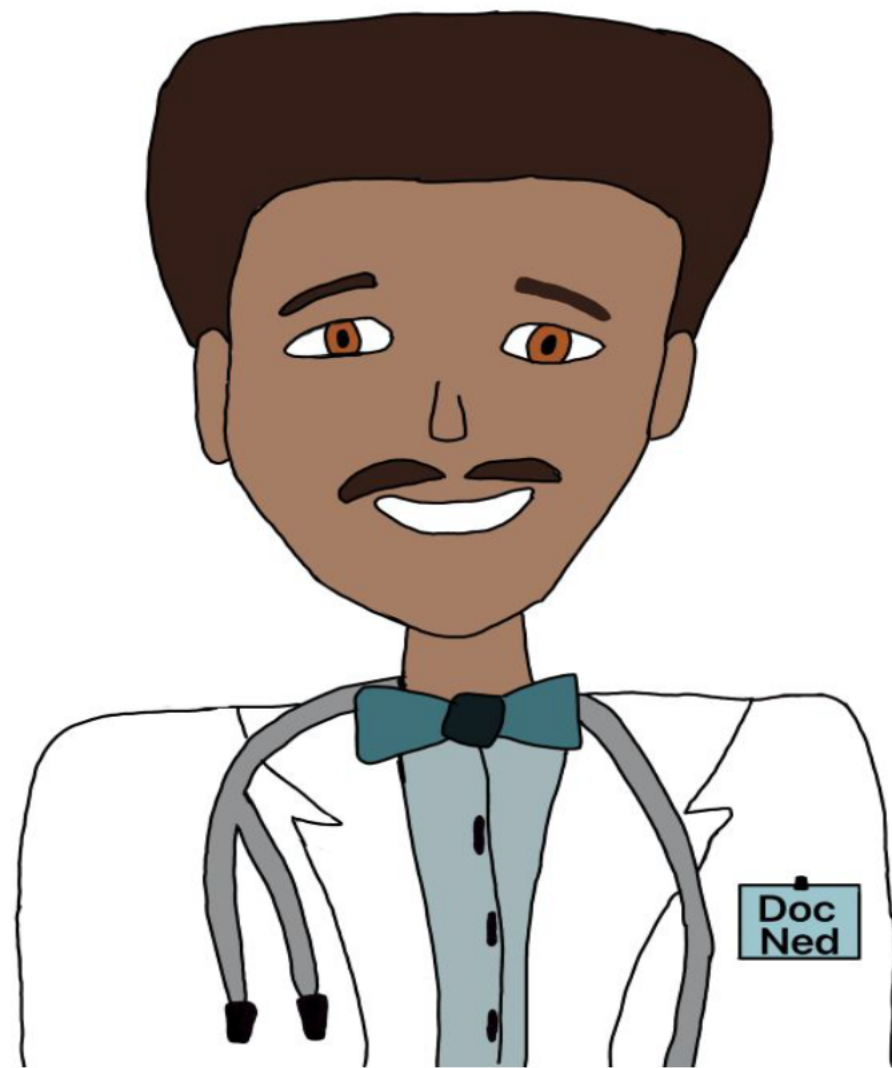


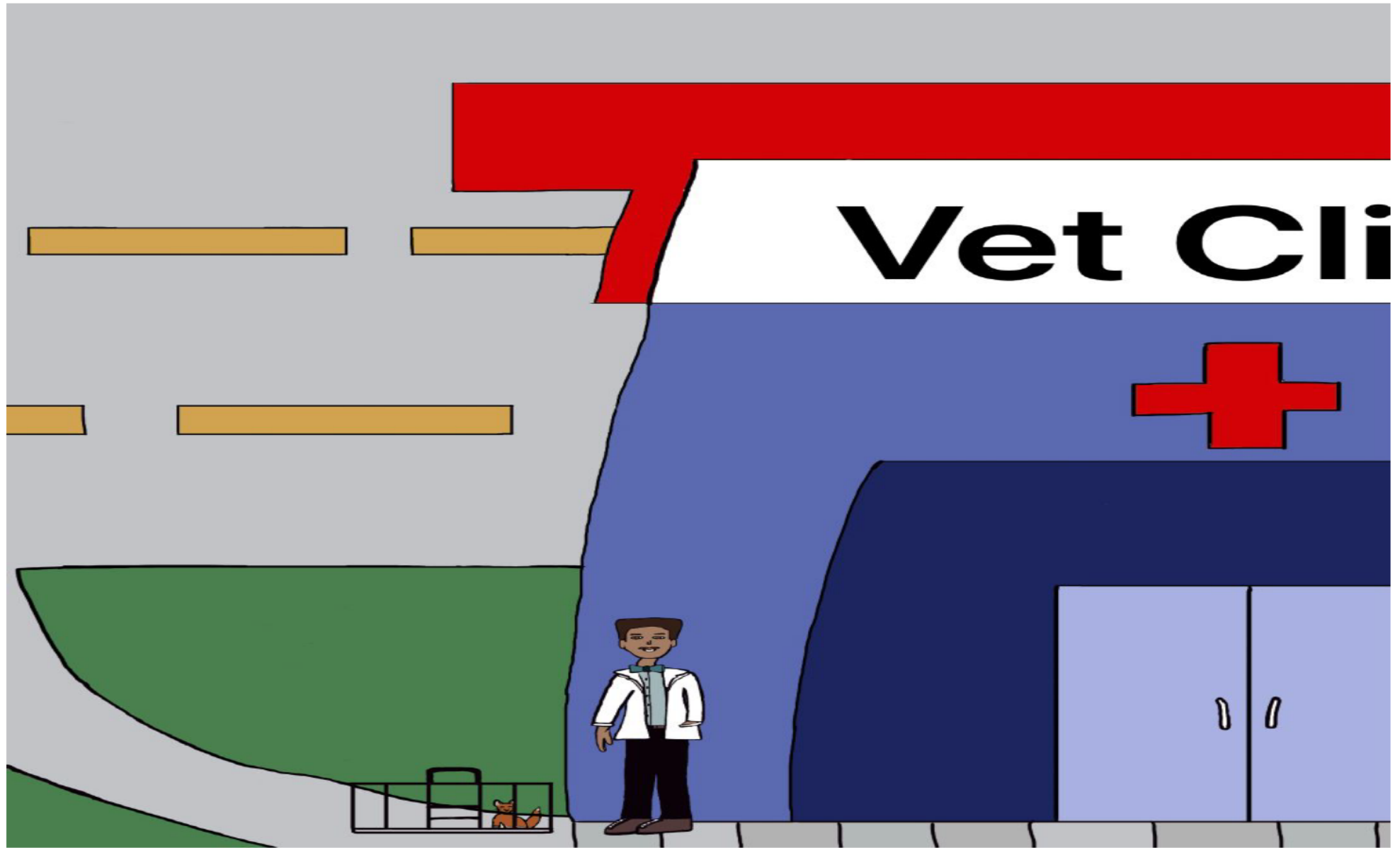
The Red Fox

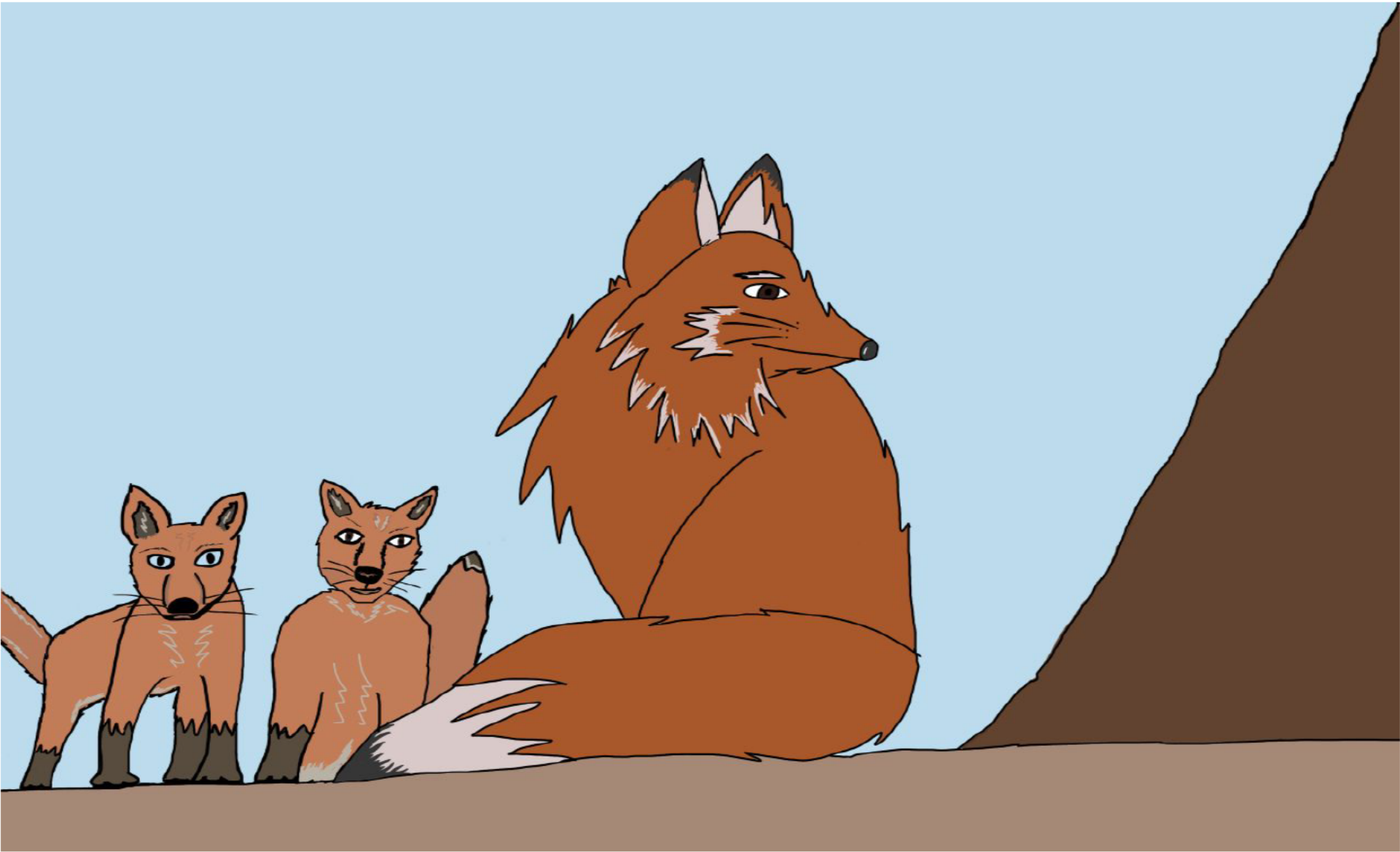
Doc Ned is a vet.

It is a baby red fox.



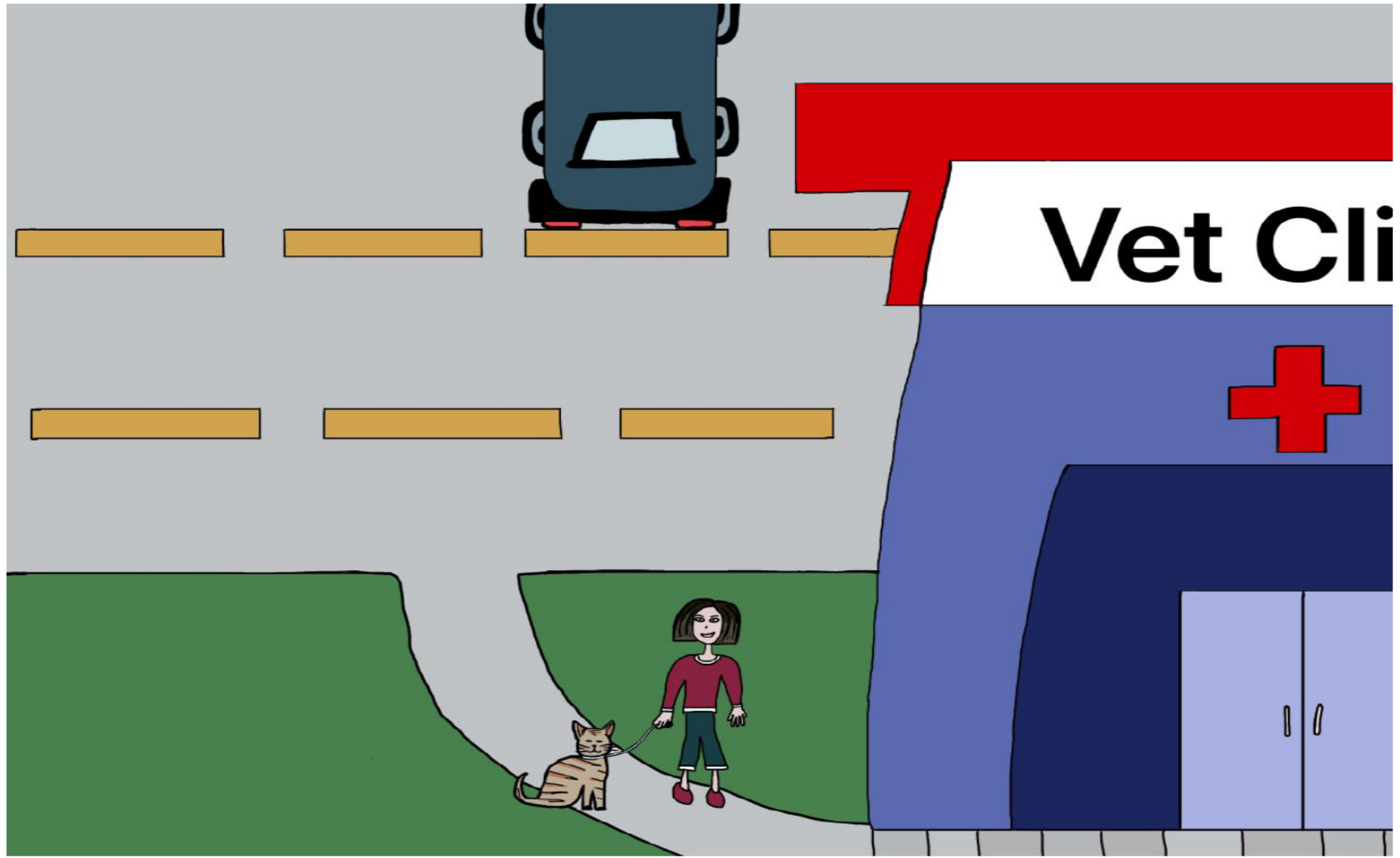
A baby fox is a kit, cub, or a pup.



Doc Ned put the fox in a pen.



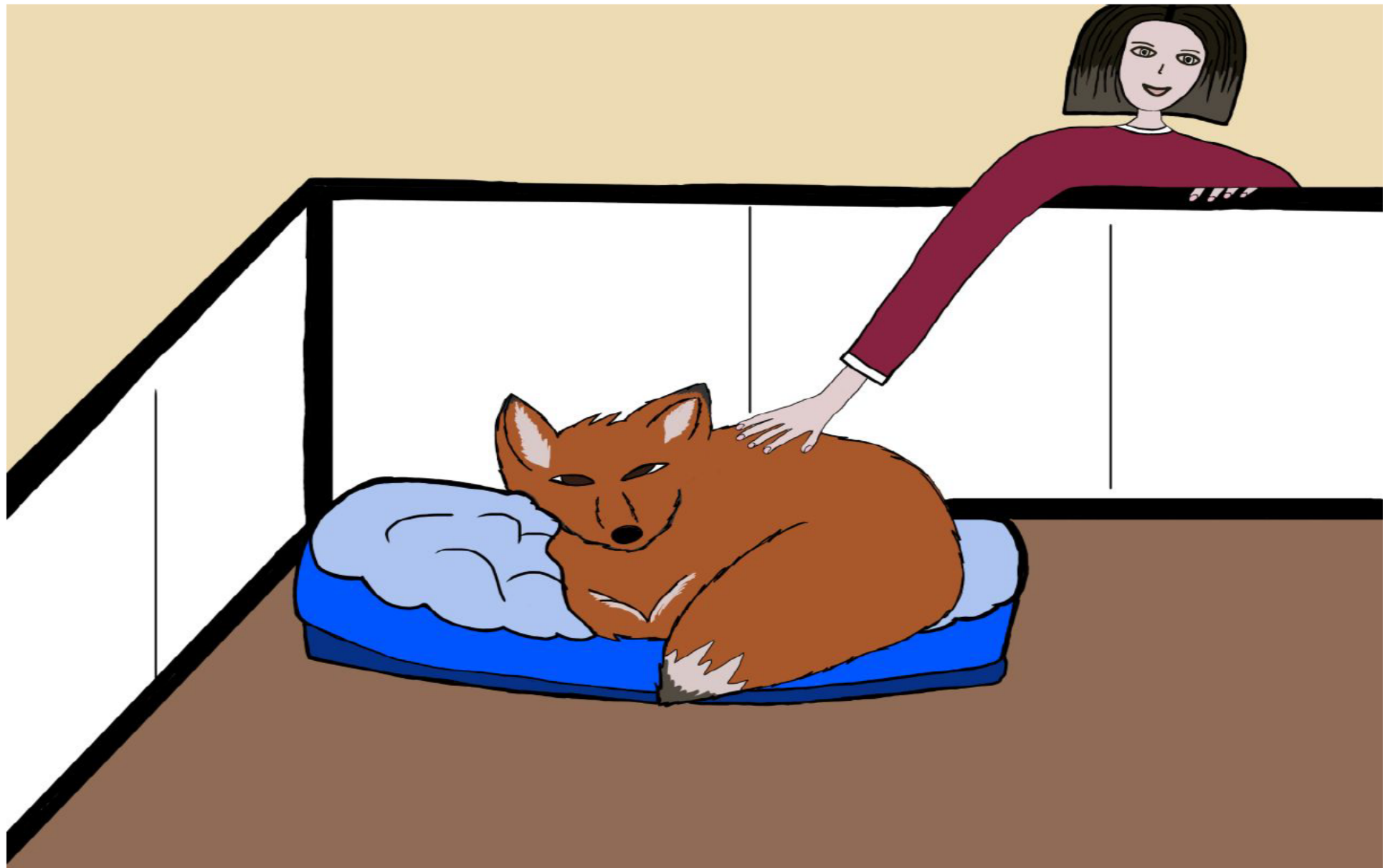
The pen is like a fox den.
