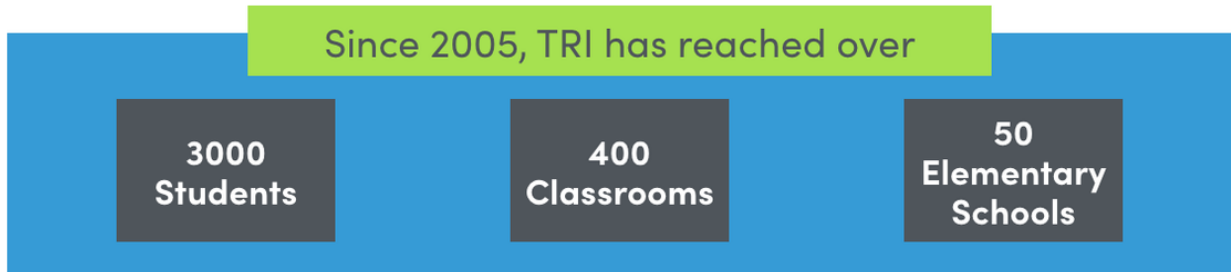


TRI Going Viral

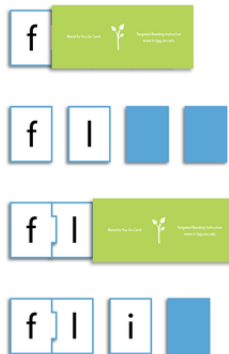
had some kindergarten teachers use these videos as part of their virtual instruction. Each video includes links to the books and materials (like how to make your own letter tiles), so everyone can join in.
