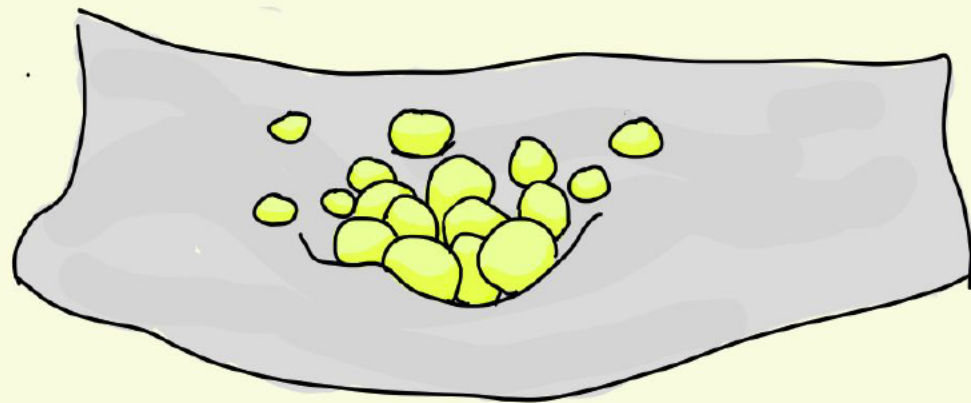


Troy is a fun boy that likes to eat.



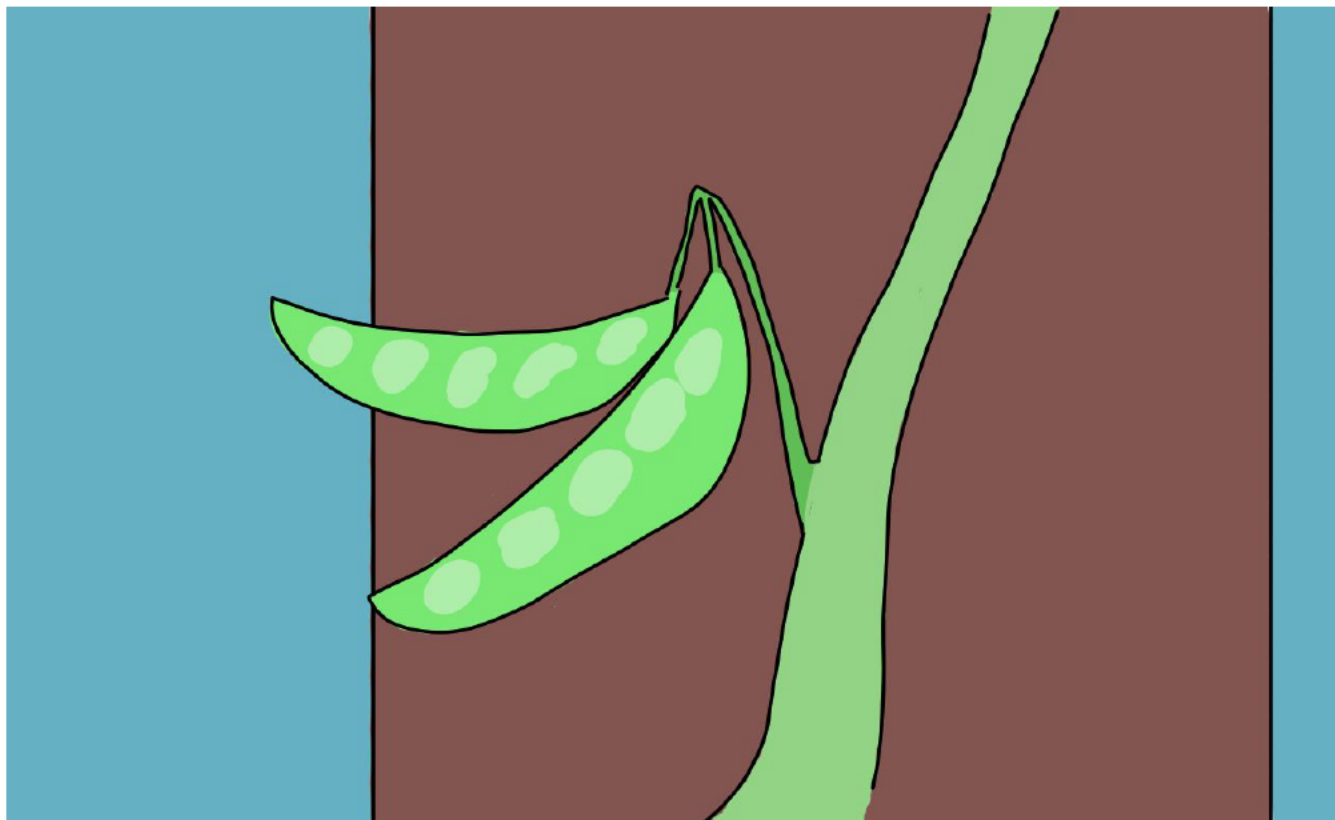
He takes a big lunch box to school each day.

Troy packs soy beans in foil and puts them in his lunch box.

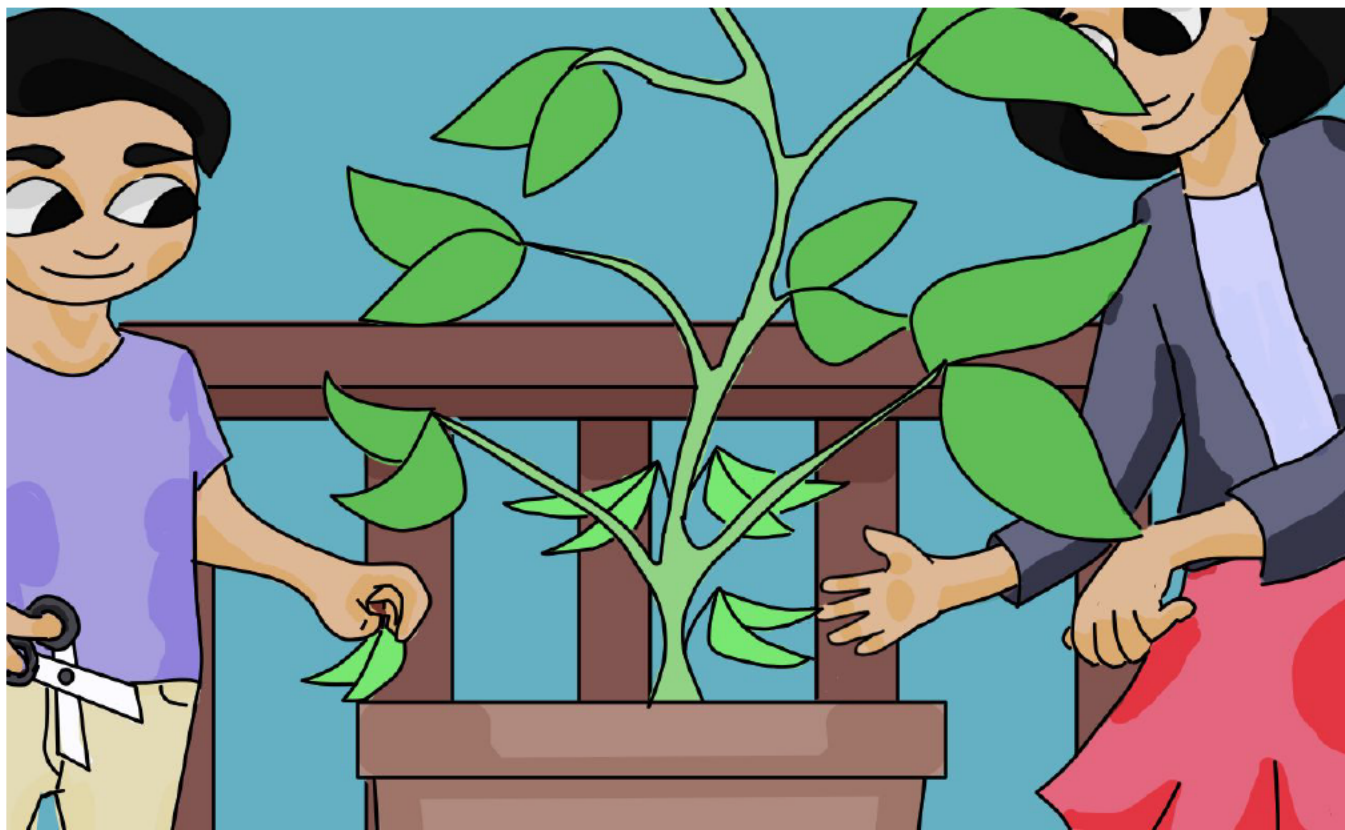




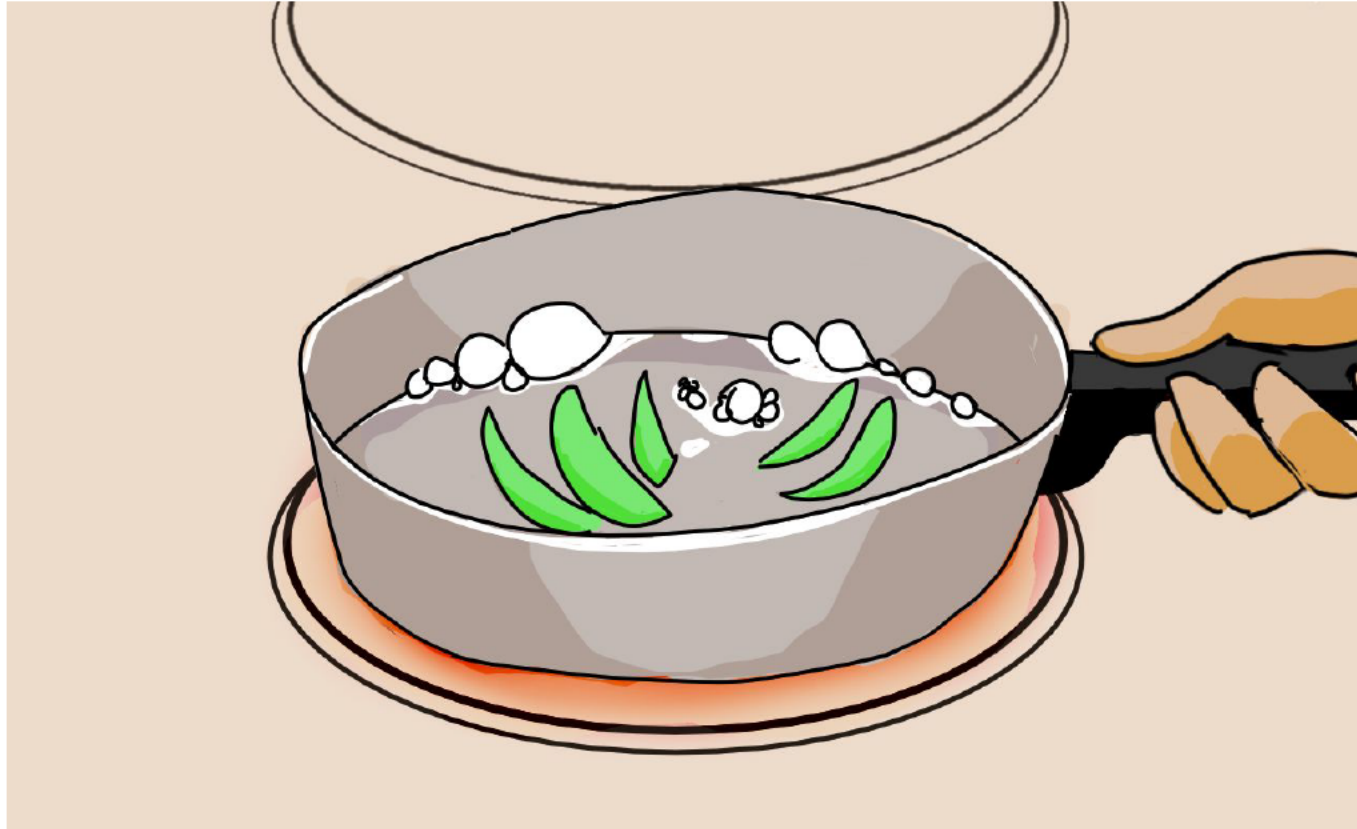
His mom plants the soy seeds in
