

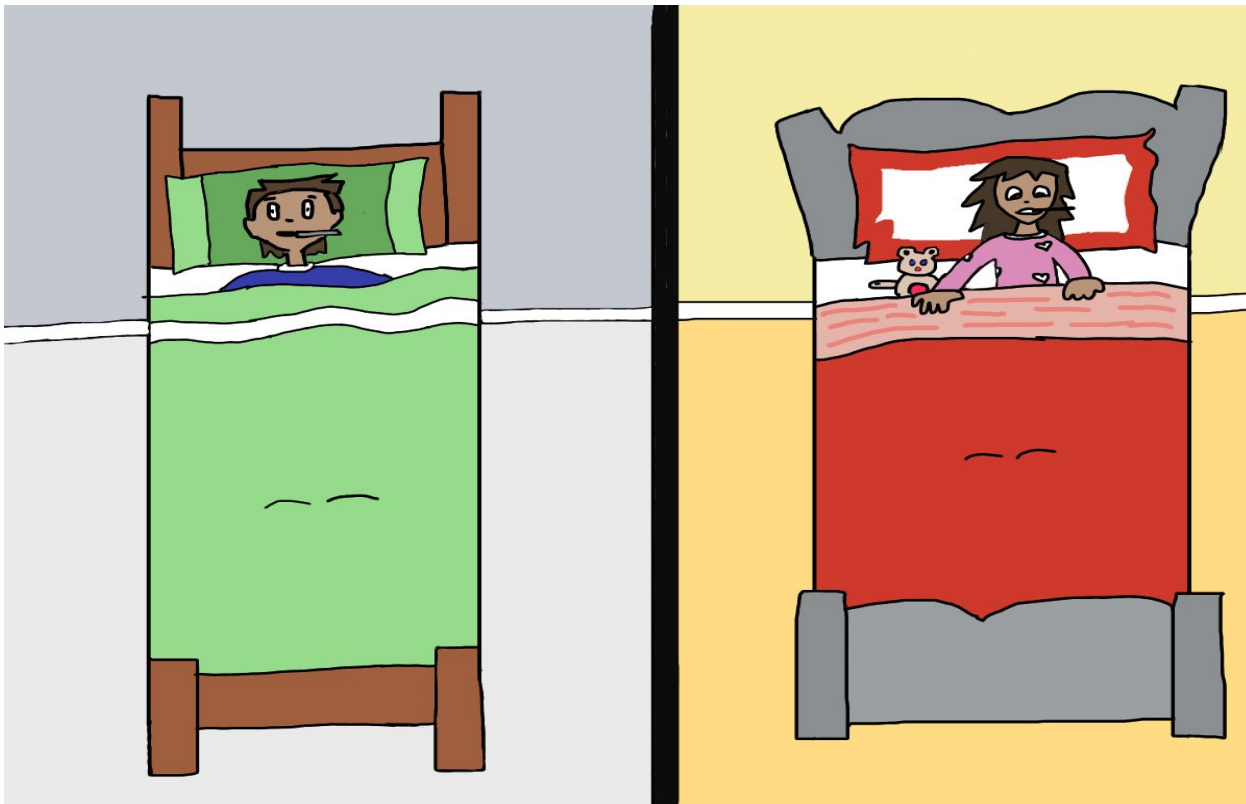
Sue's Room

school.



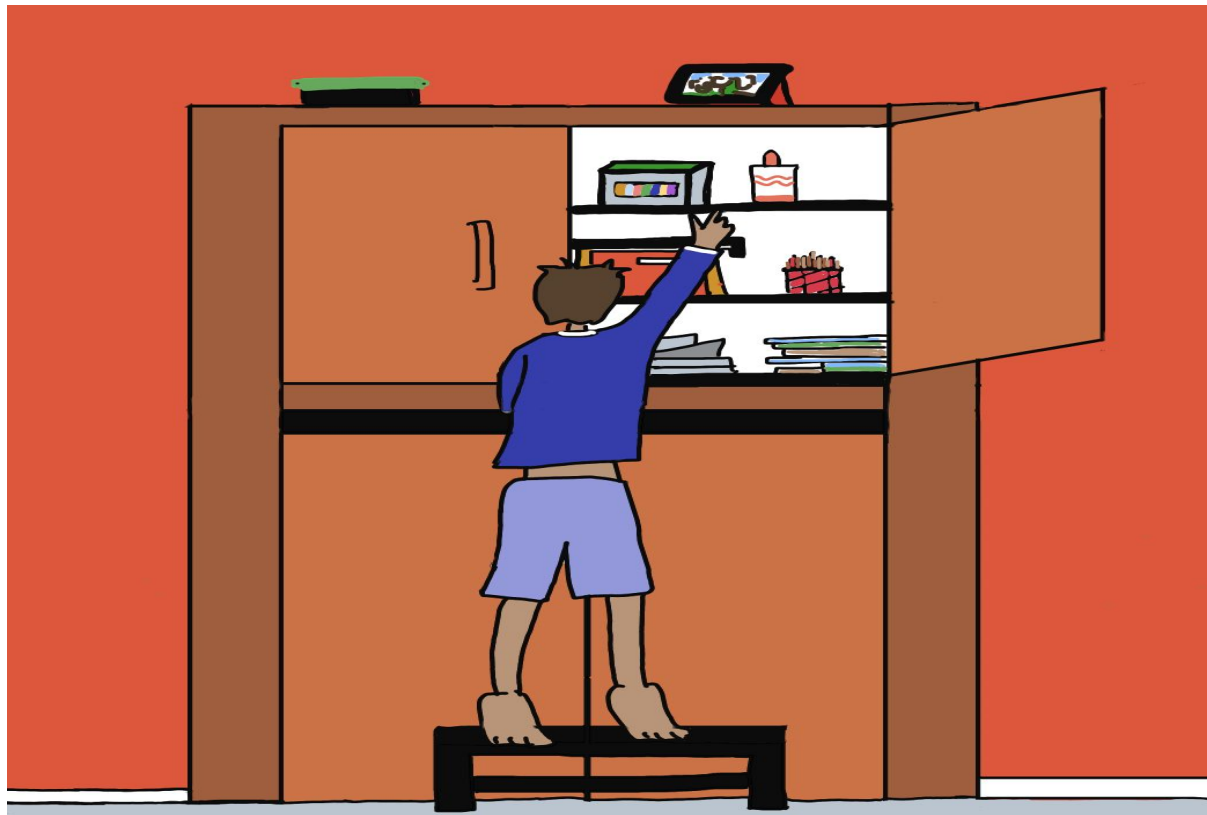
They had the flu.



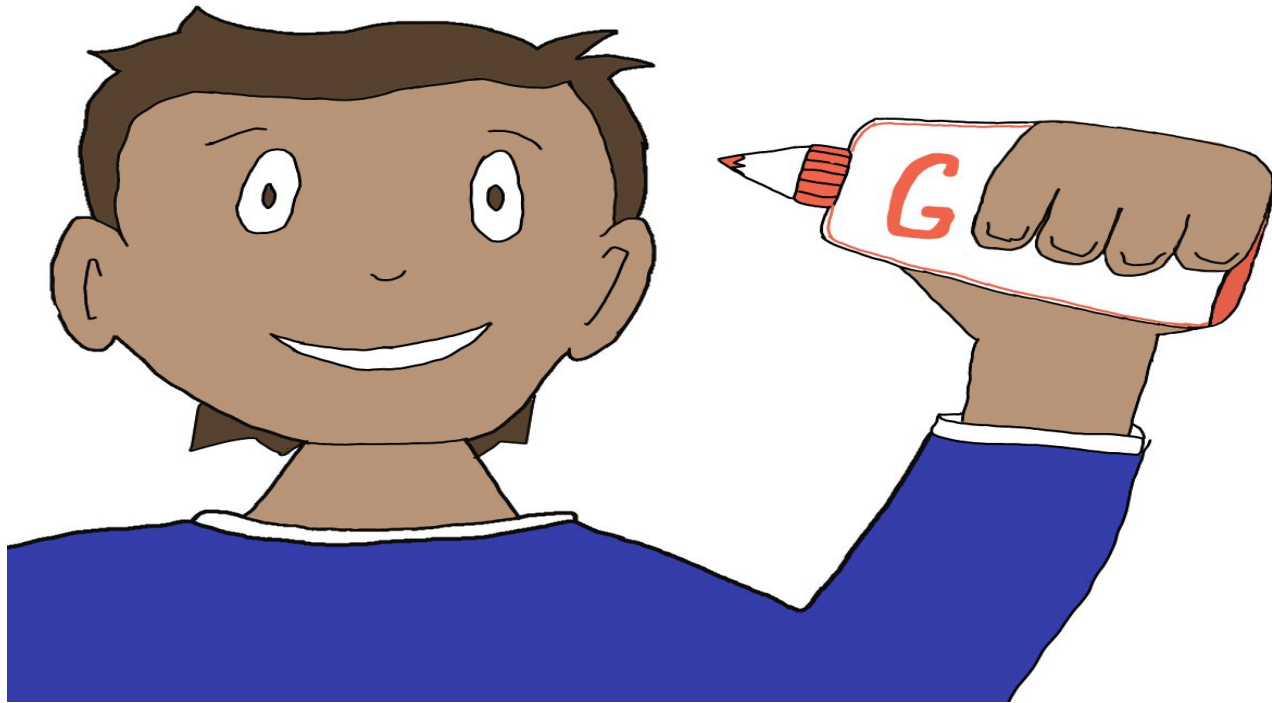
Sue sat in her room and drew.



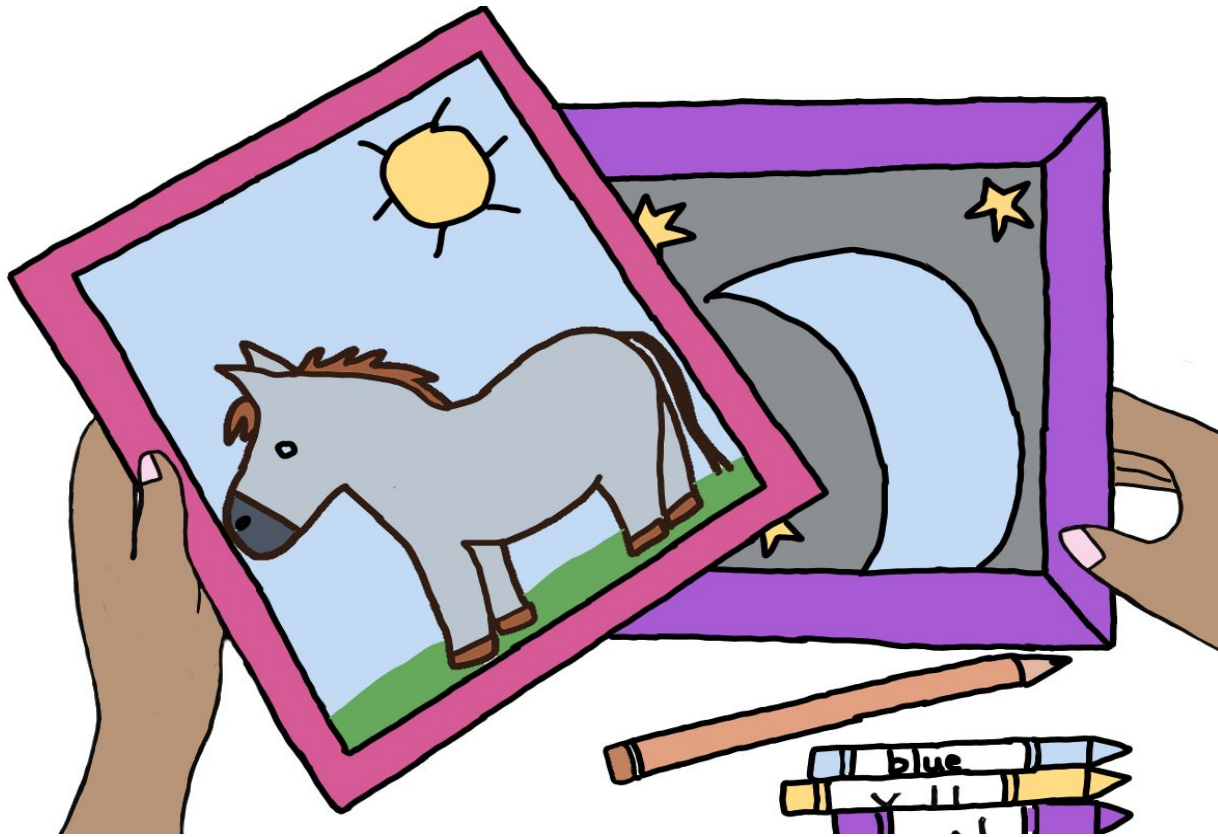
Joe ate a huge cup of soup.



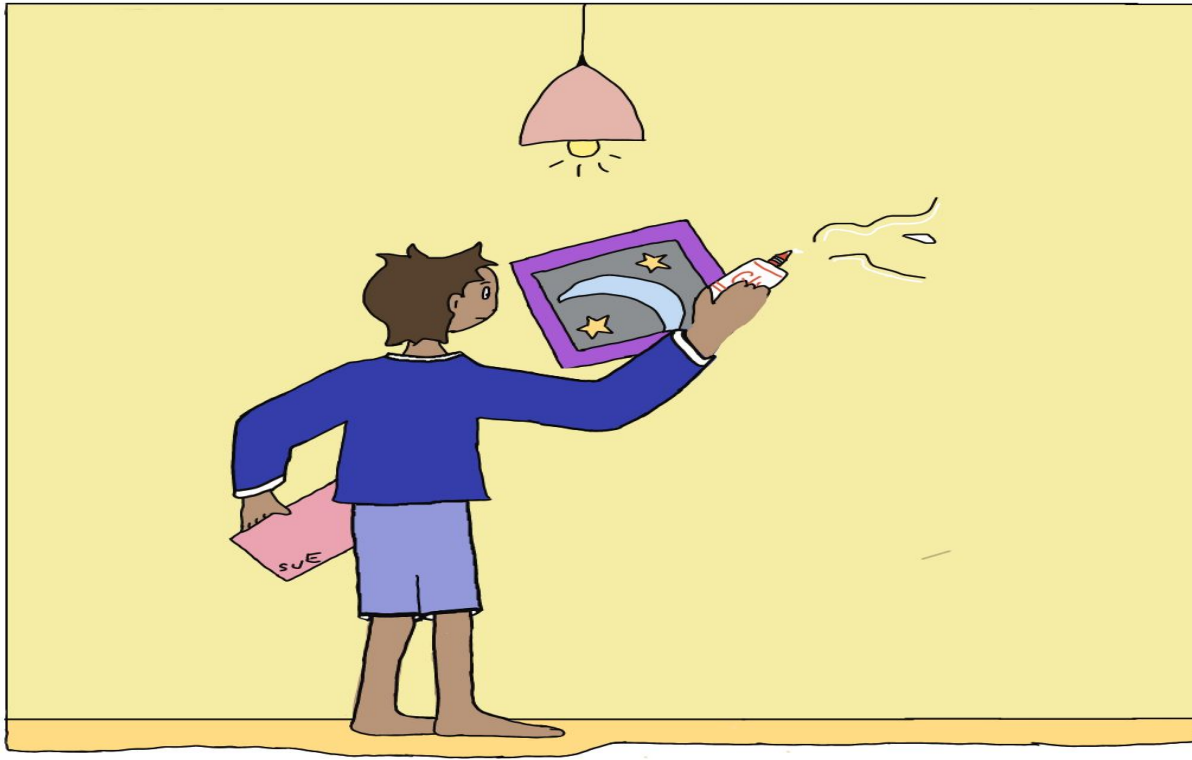
Then he got the glue and
went to Sue's room.



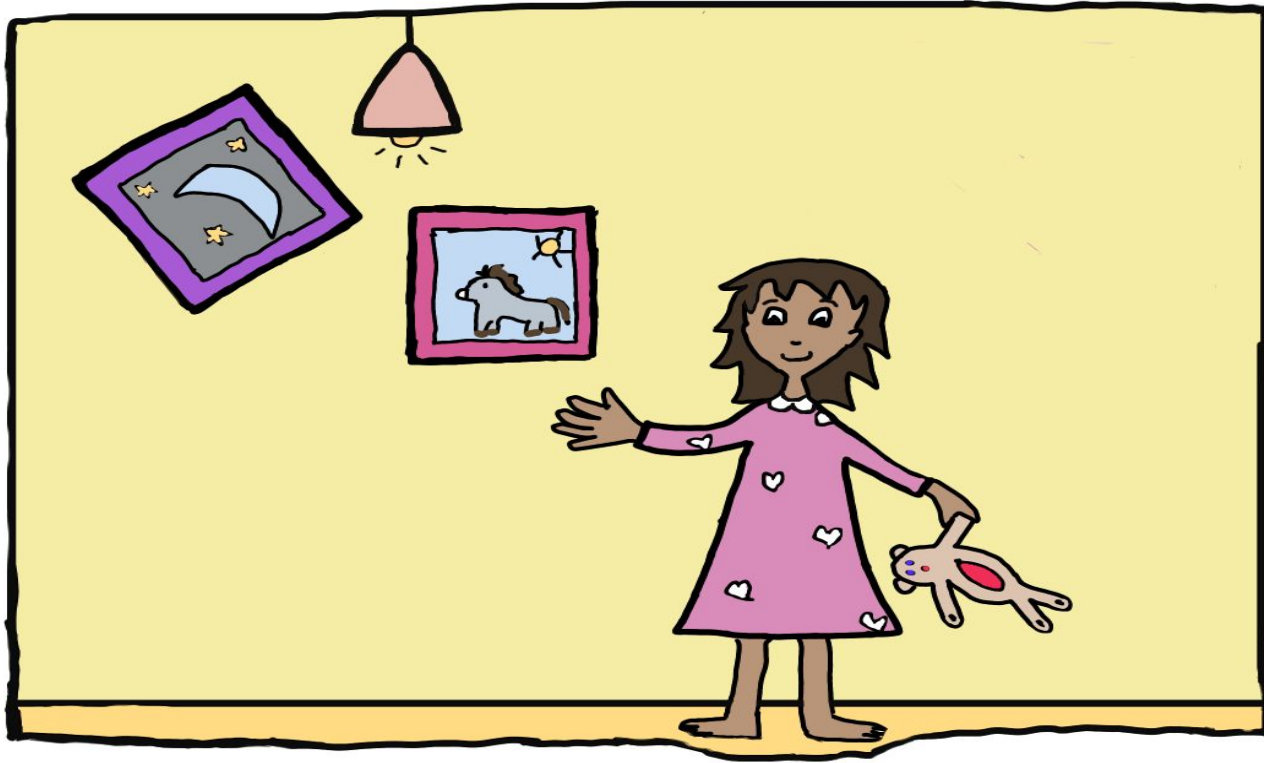
“I will use this glue to put up your new work,” he said.
