




# The Lone-Bone Ranch






Moe is the boss of an old ranch.




They call it the Lone-Bone Ranch.



Cole will help on the ranch.




Moe will show Cole the ropes.




Cole will feed the goats and

# Fun Ranch Facts!

- A *ranch* is a large area of land used for raising cows, horses, sheep, and other animals.
- A farm is a little different, a farm mostly grows and sells plants and other food.
- Animals that are raised by people and used for food and milk are called *livestock*.
- Food from plants that is grown to sell, or used to feed animals, is called a *crop*.
- A ranch may grow some crops to feed the *livestock*.
- The word *ranch* comes from the Spanish word *rancho*, which means “camp” or “place where herders live”.
